

POINTS OF PRIDE

Students at Calvary Episcopal Preparatory are our true Points of Pride. Under the direction of an outstanding professional team of educators, amazing things happen. The list below is just a few examples!

Academics

- Stanford Achievement Test mean scores are consistently two to four grade levels above the national average.
- High School students have an average of 1720 on their SAT scores and 27 on their ACT.
- 7th grade CEP students who qualify to take the College Board SAT scored 55% better than the national average for high school juniors.
- 68% of CEP 7th graders were designated as Duke University Scholars in the Duke University Talent Identification Program.
- 8th grade students have the opportunity to graduate with up to 4 high school credits.

Co-Curricular and Extra-Curricular Activities

- CEP's winning record in the District Private School Interscholastic Association (PSIA) competitions, demonstrates our superior standing in the large school category in math, science, writing, spelling, poetry, maps, charts and graphs, art, and music memory.
- Comprehensive classroom music and after school theater program includes singing, dancing, acting and stage presence all while enhancing self-esteem. Students in PreK-12 participate in all-school productions at Christmas, Easter and in the spring.
- Art is offered as an all-inclusive promotion of the visual arts. Students are instructed in different mediums including paint, sculpture, pottery and photography, to name a few. The Art Department consistently wins at both the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo Art Contest and the Fort Bend County Fair Art Contest.
- Skilled instrumental instruction in our band program develops technique, musicianship, and preparation for future competitive events begins as early as 4th grade.
- Middle school students can participate in National Junior Honor Society, National Junior Art Honor Society, International Thespian Honor Troupe, Student Council, Praise Band, History Scholars, Yearbook and Journalism, Choir, Service Learning/Projects, Family History Night and World Bazaar.
- Championship athletic teams at Calvary provide the opportunity for middle school students to engage in a variety of sports including flag football, girls and boys basketball, soccer, tennis, girls volleyball, golf, cheer, pep squad and track.
- 8th Grade students culminate their history instruction with an educational trip to Washington DC.

Upper School

- CEP is a recognized and designated as an I-20 status school. This allows us to accept exemplary international students who can study and excel in our challenging curricula.
- Graduates from CEP have been honored to receive in excess of \$120,000 in scholarships for maintaining the high standards in curricular and extra-curricular courses that are offered.
- National Honor Society, Youth in Philanthropy, International Thespian Society, Art Honor Society and Student Council represent just a few of the leadership opportunities at CEP.
- 400 hours of community service provide a greater understanding of one our three R's...Responsibility. Countless hours are devoted to leadership opportunities within the Calvary campus family.
