Lower School	\$15,115	\$3,500	\$19,115
Middle School (Grades 6-8)	\$16,342	\$3,700	\$20,132
High School (Grades 9-12)	\$18,939	\$6,100	\$25,039

Sibling Discount available – full tuition for first child, each additional sibling receives 7% discount on tuition.

****Payment must be received by July 29 or the first day of attendance if enrolling mid-year.**

Fees

All fees are non-refundable. Student Service Fee and International Fee are due with tuition by July 29, 2019.

Application Fee (New Students) \$1,000 paid with application

Returning Student Re-Enrollment Fee \$500 due at the time of re-enrollment (*\$400 if re-enrollment process completed by February 22, 2019*)

Student Service Fee – Lower & Middle School \$500 - Technology, textbooks, class activity fee, yearbook, class picture, end of year testing and scoring, health services and various other items.

Student Service Fee - High School Fee \$1,600 - Technology, textbooks, class activity fee, yearbook, class picture, end of year testing and scoring, health services and various other items.

International Fee – Lower School \$3,000 – this fee includes all additional costs for an entire year of education. Examples: daily lunch, school supplies, all club and activity fees, Tuesday breakfast fee, Annual Giving Campaign and various other items.

International Fee – Middle School \$3,200 – this fee includes all additional costs for an entire year of education. Examples: daily lunch, school supplies, all club and activity fees, Tuesday breakfast fee, Annual Giving Campaign and various other items.

International Fee – High School \$4,500 – this fee includes all additional costs for an entire year of education. Examples: daily lunch, school supplies, all club and activity fees, Tuesday breakfast fee, Annual Giving Campaign, academic competitions, field trip travel expense and various other items.
