#### Payment Options

1. Annual Payment – paid in full by **July 20, 2023\***
2. Semester Installment Plan – 2 payments **due July 20, 2023 and December 20, 2023**
3. 10-Month Installment Plan – a monthly draft administered by FACTS
4. 12-Month Installment Plan – a monthly draft administered by FACTS

#### Discounts

- Sibling Discount – full tuition for first child, each additional sibling receives **5%** discount on tuition
- Annual Payment Discount\* – tuition paid in full on or before **July 20, 2023**, receives **2%** discount on tuition

### Fees

**All fees are non-refundable. Fees are added to tuition and collected through the selected payment method.**

<b>Application Fee</b> (New Students)	\$400 paid with application
<b>Registration Fee</b> (Returning Students)	\$400 (\$300 if paid by February 6, 2023)
<b>Student Service Fee</b>	\$550 – Prekindergarten through Grade 8 \$1,700 – High School

Student Service Fee contributes to technology, textbooks, class activities, yearbook, class picture in addition to other items.

**Tuition Refund Insurance** An insurance policy that protects both families and the school in the event a student must withdraw from school. This policy assists the family with a partial payment of an unpaid tuition balance. Tuition Refund Insurance is **REQUIRED** for families enrolled in an installment payment plan.

Currently, the cost is 2.3% of the base tuition and student service fee.

**Installment Plan Service Charge** Installment payments include a \$5 fee per installment.

## Activity & Sport Fees

We currently offer the following after-school sports and activities at various times during the school year:

**Flag football, volleyball, soccer, basketball, track, tennis, badminton, and golf**

**Per Child: \$125 per sport**

### Archery and Riflery

Through our partnership with Long Acres Ranch, these two activities are offered to CEP students by their certified instructors. CEP provides afterschool transportation to practices but any participation, equipment, and competition fees are set by the provider.

### Cheerleading and Pep Squad

Fees Per Child: Cheerleading (grades 6-12), Uniform up to **\$450**; Pep Squad (grades 2 – 5), **\$75 fee**

## Extended Day

The Extended Day program provides childcare services under the direction of Calvary staff members and is based in the multi-purpose room across the hall from the gym. It is offered every day school is in session from 3:30 to 6:30 p.m.
